The EU Directive 2002/95/EC "Restriction on the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances" (RoHS) requires all Member States (per Article 4(1) of the Directive) to ensure that materials and components of electrical and electronic equipment put on the market after 1 July 2006 do not contain listed hazardous substances.

We have reviewed our products with regard to the EU Directive 2002/95/EC and based on our current knowledge of the products and the information (such as safety data sheets) provided to Finished Metals, Inc. by its raw material suppliers, the products we manufacture does not contain cadmium, hexavalent chromium, lead, mercury, polybrominated biphenyls (PBBs) or polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDEs) at levels greater than the tolerated maximum concentration values established by the EU Commission Decision 2005/618/EC.

In addition we do not source materials on the current SVHC list under EU REACH legislation for the products we manufacture.
