

## USING LASERLIGHTS SHEETS

The LaserLIGHTS laminate is a thin sheet of a base color with a micro surface of a top color applied. A strong adhesive on the back allows it to be applied to a plaque or gift item then laser engraved and cut.

Using maximum speed and low power, the laser can easily remove the top coating to reveal rich colors underneath. After the engraving process is complete, the laser can cut out the engraved piece giving it a smooth, finished look. Frequently LaserLIGHTS is mistaken for inlaid metal!

Achieving professional results with LaserLIGHTS is easy and adds tremendous value to your project.



- The process for creating a decorative addition to a gift item starts with lightly applying a small piece of LaserLIGHTS.
- Engrave and cut the LaserLIGHTS using low power settings for best results.
- Typical settings for 35 watt system are 100 speed and 35 power for engraving, 20 speed and 30 power for cutting.
- After laser cutting, remove the outside of the engraved logo and burnish the area with the smooth side of the white paper backing.
